Dear parents,

before applying for a reduction from the Familienservice, please apply for a grant from the Office for Children, Youth and Family Affairs of the Freiburg city administration (AKi Freiburg). The AKi will examine whether you qualify for a grant that will cover your parental fee wholly or partially.

After receiving the AKi's decision, please hand over their answer to us. This is beneficial for you in the following way: If the AKi determines that it will give you a grant that covers your parental fee (wholly or partially), we will automatically charge you the reduced parental fee. In this case, you do not need to fill out this form (the answer from the AKi is enough).

Only if the AKi declines to give you a grant, you will need to fill out this form and hand in all the required documents to us. We will then examine whether you will pay the regular or the reduced parental fee. Please send the form and the documents to: <u>familienservice@uni-freiburg.de</u>
